## Why early intervention?

How to sign up for a screening?

1. Parent of legal guardian
  - A. Sign release form.
  - B. Fill out questionnaire
  - C. Return brochure to the teacher at the school or daycare.
  - D. Make a payment via cash or check to the therapist.

\*Payment can be applied to your private payment of an evaluation, if further treatment or evaluation is recommended.

2. Screenings are completed at the child's daycare or school (takes approximately 20 minutes).
3. Written results of the screening will be provided within 3-5 business days.

## Screening Options

### What is an Occupational Therapy screening?

The following areas will be screened:

- Handwriting
- Sensory integration
- Attention
- Fine motor skills
- Hand-eye coordination

### What is a Speech and Language screening?

The following areas will be screened:

- Articulation (pronunciation)
- Fluency (stuttering)
- Receptive language (understanding)
- Expressive language (using words and/or forming sentences)
- Auditory processing
- Phonological awareness
- Swallowing

### What is a Physical Therapy screening?

The following areas will be screened:

- Gross motor skills
- Gross motor coordination
- Strength, flexibility and endurance
- Posture and gait
- Balance
